A Proven Process for Parish Evangelization


Introduction

ChristLife is an apostolate of the Archdiocese of Baltimore founded in 1995 to train and equip Catholic parishes for the Church's essential mission of evangelization. ChristLife offers a 3-step evangelization process which provides parishes with a relational way to make missionary disciples by helping people discover, follow, and share Jesus Christ as members of the Catholic Church.

In the past ten years over 150,000 people from 1,000 parishes in the United States and internationally have experienced the ChristLife evangelization process.

The ChristLife Evangelization Process

The ChristLife Evangelization Process consists of three courses: Discovering Christ, Following Christ, and Sharing Christ. Driven by the missionary mandate of the Lord Jesus, the ChristLife Process is intended to be repeated each year and become part of the parish's core curriculum for adult faith formation and evangelization.. A number of parishes have been running the ChristLife Process for nearly 10 years, and are reaching not only active Catholics, but nominal and inactive Catholics, and the unbaptized.





Discovering Christ is a 7-week experience of the first announcement of the Gospel or *kerygma* that includes a meal, video presentation, and small group discussion.

Available in Spanish.



Following Christ is a 7-week journey of Catholic discipleship that includes prayer, a video presentation, and small group discussion.

Available in Spanish Fall 2019.



Sharing Christ is a 7-week course on how to personally evangelize that includes prayer, a video presentation, and small group discussion.

Available in Spanish Spring 2020.

The cost for the *Complete Evangelization Kit* is \$1,170. The kit includes all video and written materials needed to run all three courses of the ChristLife Process. It also comes with a *Parish Printing License*, which provides parishes with digital copies of all of the course materials and permission to print unlimited copies.



Training Parish Leaders for Evangelization

The two primary ways ChristLife trains parish leaders to evangelize using the ChristLife Process is the National Conference and Diocesan Training Conferences.

- National Conference. An annual three-day training event providing comprehensive training in the ChristLife courses. In 2019, the conference was held in Baltimore. In 2020, the conference will be held in Denver. The average registration cost per person is \$200.
- **Diocesan Training Conferences.** ChristLife partners with (arch) dioceses to provide training to parish leaders in the ChristLife courses. The 2019-2020 pricing for a Diocesan Training Conference, which is Friday night and all day Saturday, is \$5,000, plus travel for our team.

In the last ten years ChristLife has partnered with 17 Catholic (arch)dioceses, providing diocesan-level training to over 2,000 parish leaders in:
