

The Aim of Evangelization is Conversion

"The proclamation of the Word of God has Christian conversion as its aim: a complete and sincere adherence to Christ and His Gospel through faith...Conversion means accepting by personal decision the saving sovereignty of Christ and becoming His disciple."

The Need to Evangelize

"The sacred liturgy does not exhaust the entire activity of the Church; it must be preceded by evangelization, faith and conversion. It can then produce its fruits in the lives of the faithful; new life in the Spirit, involvement in the mission of the Church, and service to her unity."


Personal Encounter with Christ





Each session includes:


A meal (only Discovering Christ)
