
He called all Catholics to pray after each Sunday Mass for a new Pentecost as the Church prepared for a Vatican Council to address the realities the Church faced in this present age:

“O Divine Spirit, renew your wonders in this our day as by a new Pentecost.”

This cry to the Holy Spirit was answered in the most wonderful and miraculous way for Catholics and other Christians in the 1960s and onwards. The Lord poured out his Spirit across the nations.

As an example of how wonderful the Lord answered this prayer, Leo was a faithful Catholic, raising a wonderful family and holding a good job. At some point a parishioner shared with

him how he needed to know Jesus personally. Leo recognized that he was just “checking off the boxes” when it came to Mass and his faith. He was led to encounter the Lord in the power of the Holy Spirit and everything black and white became technicolor!

We’ve been empowered by the Holy Spirit to share with others the most wonderful news of our Father who loves us, who forgives our sins through what Christ has done for us, and gives us power, the Holy Spirit, to live as his sons and daughters and members of his Body, the Church.

As we celebrate our 30th anniversary,

together let us thank and praise God and, personally renew our surrender to the Lord Jesus “who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.” (Revelations 1:5b,6)

Let’s persevere in prayer for one another and redouble our efforts to help others discover, follow, and share Jesus Christ.


WELCOME, JOANN!
